Attached are brochures for Fall 2016 session of **Southern New Jersey Consortium for Gifted and Talented Students**. These brochures should be distributed to any student whom you feel meets the criteria outlined below **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE**.

Criteria:

- * Student must be in Grade 1-8
- * Minimum of 95th percentile on normal referenced test (composite, math or reading) or "Advanced Proficient" status on New Jersey ASK testing

OR

*Teacher recommendation (Students do not have to be in the Gifted and Talented program)
The recommendation form says student is, "performing well in my class and demonstrates the characteristics that would benefit from and/or contribute to this program".

Classes for the Fall session will begin on **Saturday, October 15th** at the Galloway Township Middle School, 100 Reeds Road, Galloway, N.J. It is important that these brochures are **distributed to your students as early as possible**, as classes are scheduled on a first come, first served basis.
